TeleCare Audiology! Have a smart phone? New devices from **ReSound** or **Signia** (Siemens) enable me to adjust your hearing aids from my office by sending encrypted and secure data to you—no matter where you are!

Phonak and **Signia** now offer 24 hours of hearing on a single 90-minute charge! No more waiting 5-6 hours or being cut short after you have had your “ears in” for 12 hours. The encased rechargeable battery last 3 years and is replaceable. However, you cannot use disposable batteries with these types of devices.

Signia has developed “flex-fit” demo devices. I can give you a short trial with entry-level, mid-level, or premium-level circuitry. This can help you in choosing the level of technology that meets your listening needs before we place your order. There is a \$250 charge for this flex demo. But a credit is applied once you place an order.

ReSound Linx 3-D uses an upgraded, binaural directionality to focus on sounds important to you without losing touch with what is going on around you.

Phonak Virto B-Titanium is a super discreet (deep in the canal fit) that is 15x stronger than acrylic and is water and dust resistant. You will need excellent dexterity to be able to change batteries every 3 days in these tiny devices.

What is Aural Rehab?


